PICK-A-PRO RULES

You will draw 3 players from the TOP 20 that made the cut, thus giving you a "foursome."

We will pair their Sunday 18-hole scores with your 18 hole NET and GROSS score giving you a "foursome total."

- You can play either or both days. Saturday or Sunday
- (*If you play both days, only your best score will count)
- You must have a GHIN HDCP to be eligible to win in the NET portion.
- 100% of your COURSE HANDICAP is used.
- We will use the "Shots Off Calculation" if anyone that participates with a (+) HDCP.
- Open to Men and Women and Guests.

*Note-There could be times when a "Pro" Golfer is on multiple teams as each time a "foursome" is drawn, all players go back in the hat.

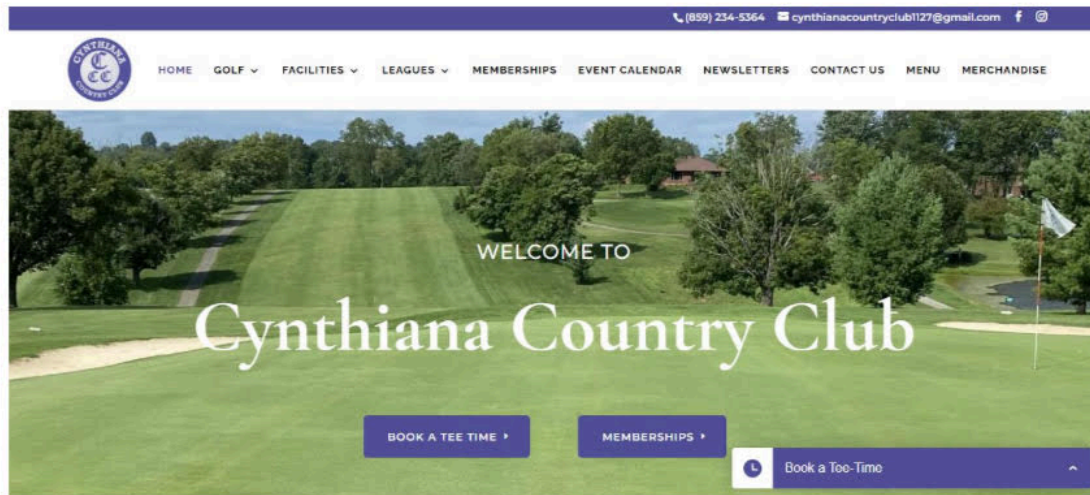

MGA 2024 THURSDAY LEAGUE

Starts April 4th thru October 24th

- **Teams:**
 - Made up of 4 players. (All players must be MGA Members \$20 annual fee)
 - (You can play anytime Thursday that works for your team – tee times required)
 - \$20.00 league entry fee per player and weekly fee of \$5 per player to the pot.
 - Any new player added to a team during the playing season will pay the \$20 entry fee.
- **Format**
 - 9 Holes of stroke play, rotating tees each week.
 - If you want to play 18 holes, great just play the “league” 9 first.
- **HDCP's:**
 - For returning players, you will begin with your Thursday League HDCP from last year.
 - New players GHIN Handicaps will be used for the 1st week and League HDCP will then be established.
 - There will be a “no higher than” HDCP limit of 18 for 9 holes.
 - 60 & over = Senior Tees
 - 75 & over = Super Senior Tees
 - Note that your Thursday night HDCP will not match your GHIN. It's simply an average of your league scores. If your average league score is 40, then your “League HDCP” is a (4).
- **Subs**
 - If you would like to be an “on-call” Sub, please provide the Pro Shop your name and cell #. It is the responsibility of the team to contact the sub.
 - If you have less than 4 players and can't find a sub for that day, you will be allowed to “draw” a player from those playing that day on another team.

Each player participating on that Thursday will be assigned a number and you will draw as many as you need to fill out your 4-some and use their net scores to fill out your team total. *Note that you will be responsible to pay the \$5 weekly fee per player and while we would suggest that share any winnings with them, this is your call.

- **Scoring Details**

- All four net scores will be used. (Maximum score allowed per hole = Double Bogey)
- Gross score for each player will be entered on the scorecard as usual.
- On the bottom half of the scorecard the lowest net score of the team is entered in the Net1 line.
- Second lowest net score is entered in Net 2 line, etc, etc.
- Payouts will be:
- Net 1 lowest score 40% of pot.
- Net 2 lowest score 30% of pot.
- Net 3 lowest score 20% of pot.
- Net 4 lowest score 10% of pot.

Minutes from the March 2024 Board Meeting were approved.

Staff Report: Grant Howard

- Greens are in great shape from the aeration on March 18th.
- Looking to add sod cut from the range to some tee boxes.
- Weed kill on fairways was not as effective as usual due to warmer temps.
- Working with the Drain Doctor to repair leak at the bottom of #5 once the weather warms up.

Staff Report: Amanda

- State did not pass a bill that would have required the club to have 2 lifeguards on duty at all times, so we can proceed as we have in the past.

Financial Report: Lynn Northcutt

- Thru March
 - Income
 - Membership dues are up \$20,197 vs LYR
 - Total Revenue is up \$29,852 vs LYR
 - Expenses
 - Total Expenses up \$17,744 vs LYR
 - Callouts
 - Maintenance/Repair/supplies expenses on clubhouse and grounds are up \$5984 (Mower Reels, Hand Sink, Mop sink, etc)
 - Started paying our Golf Cart lease/insurance earlier than last year. Up \$3624
 - Sales tax up \$7628
 - Labor up \$1131 (Painting kitchen, etc)
 - POS Software up \$802
- Motion made by Scott Sullivan and 2nd by Brian Kinsey to approve all the above reports.
 - Motion carried.

Old Business

- POS system implementation has begun. Still working out some of the nuances and the members are asked to be patient. *Note that members can now book tee times online if we have their email address and cell numbers updated in the system. Instructions are in the April Newsletter.
- Discussed the upstairs rental fees. It was decided that more research was needed before making changes. Tabled to the May meeting.
- Internet/tv plans were tabled to the May meeting.
