Kentucky Golf Association Announces 2025 Schedule

LOUISVILLE, KY (February 6, 2025) – The Kentucky Golf Association (KGA) unveiled its 2025 tournament schedule today. With many new courses and a variety of formats, this season proves to fit all amateur golfers across the state. Registration for tournaments will open on March 5th.

The schedule opens on Friday, April 18th at the inaugural East/West Cup matches, played at Elizabethtown Country Club. This new invitational will feature the top players from the 2024 player of the year standings in a Ryder Cup type format between Eastern Kentucky and Western Kentucky.

The Pearl Club hosts the first of six KGA Amateur Series events on April 28th. The amateur series will conclude with the championship being held September 11th at Persimmon Ridge in Louisville.

The KGA heads to Prospect, KY on June 9-11 for the 97th playing of the Clark's Pump-N-Shop Women's State Amateur held at Nevel Meade Golf Club.

The schedule is highlighted by the six Clark's Pump-N-Shop championships, notably the 111th playing of the Clark's Pump-N-Shop Kentucky Men's Amateur contested at Lexington Country Club on June 23-25. Eight qualifiers will be held across the Commonwealth, including the second chance qualifier at Elizabethtown CC on June 3rd.

Later in the summer, the KGA heads back to Lexington for the Clark's Pump-N-Shop Men's Match Play Championship on August 6-8 at Kearney Hill Golf Links. Then a quick turnaround for the Clark's Pump-N-Shop Men's State Mid-Amateur Championship held at Owensboro Country Club on August 18-19.

Following a busy summer, the Clark's Pump-N-Shop Women's Senior State Amateur kicks off the fall at Henry County Country Club on September 8-9. Followed up by the final Clark's series event, the Clark's Pump-N-Shop Men's Senior State Amateur at Indian Hills Country Club on September 22-23.

The KGA will also conduct five USGA qualifiers throughout the year, starting with the U.S. Open Local Qualifier at Traditions Golf Club in early May and concluding with the U.S. Mid-Amateur qualifier at The Club at Olde Stone in mid August.

The Kentucky Golf Association (KGA) is one of the three organizations encompassed under Golf House Kentucky, in addition to the Kentucky Golf Foundation (KGF) and Kentucky PGA Section (KPGA). The Kentucky Golf Association represents the amateur body of Kentucky's golfers working in assistance with the United States Golf Association (USGA). The KGA provides its Member Clubs with a wide range of services, including handicapping, USGA course and slope ratings, and tournament management software. The KGA also operates the state's premier amateur tournaments along with USGA National Championship qualifiers. Alongside the KGF and KPGA, the KGA strives to promote the benefits and enjoyment of golf while continuing to grow the sport across the Commonwealth.
