MGA 2025 THURSDAY LEAGUE

Starts April 3rd thru October 23rd

Teams:

- Made up of 4 players. (All players must be MGA Members \$20 annual fee)
 - (You can play anytime Thursday that works for your team tee times required)
- \$20.00 league entry fee per player and weekly fee of \$5 per player to the pot.
- Any new player added to a team during the playing season will pay the \$20 entry fee.

Format

- o 9 Holes of stroke play, rotating tees each week.
- o If you want to play 18 holes, great just play the "league" 9 first.

· HDCP's:

- For returning players, you will begin with your Thursday League HDCP from last year.
- New players GHIN Handicaps will be used for the 1st week and League HDCP will then be established.
- There will be a "no higher than" HDCP limit of 18 for 9 holes.
- o 60 & over = Senior Tees
- 75 & over = Super Senior Tees
 - Note that your Thursday night HDCP will not match your GHIN. It's simply an average of your league scores. If your average league score is 40, then your "League HDCP" is a (4).

Subs

- If you would like to be an "on-call" Sub, please provide the Pro Shop your name and cell #. It is the responsibility of the team to contact the sub.
- If you have less than 4 players and can't find a sub for that day, you will be allowed to "draw" a player from those playing that day on another team.


Each player participating on that Thursday will be assigned a number and you will draw as many as you need to fill out your 4-some and use their net scores to fill out your team total. *Note that you will be responsible to pay the \$5 weekly fee per player and while we would suggest that share any winnings with them, this is your call.

Scoring Details

- All four net scores will be used.
- Maximum score allowed per hole = Gross Double Bogey
- Gross score for each player will be entered on the scorecard as usual.
- On the bottom half of the scorecard the lowest net score of the team is entered in the Net1 line.
- o Second lowest net score is entered in Net 2 line, etc, etc.
- Payouts will be:
- Net 1 lowest score 40% of pot.
- Net 2 lowest score 30% of pot.
- Net 3 lowest score 20% of pot.
- Net 4 lowest score 10% of pot.
